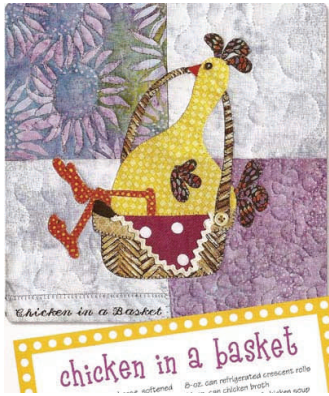

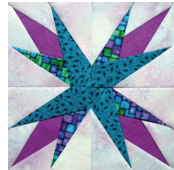
Paper Piecing Basics

I have heard you say "I don't know how to paper-piece" so here is your chance. Come learn some of the tips and tricks I have learned over the years and then you can do it too.

Raw Edge Appliqué

You picked up your final block in May. We gave you June and July to finish it and now is the time to let us see them. We are planning a mystery club picnic on Saturday Aug 2 at 12:00. Bring your quilt (in whatever stage it is in) and a lawn chair. We will provide the hot dogs, ice tea and lemonade. We will take pictures to send to the designer. If you weren't part of the mystery club, come join the fun and see all the quilts. If you sign up for the new mystery club between Aug 2 and Aug 8, you will get \$2.00 off the registration fee. The club will be run different this year. We will not be providing a fabric packet each month. You will purchase all your fabric up front and keep it. You will receive just the clue each month.

End of Bolt

Any time you take what is left on a bolt in our store, you get 30% off the total price of that piece.

Retreat Bucks

Our computer keeps track of your buying. When you go on a retreat with us, you get 1 retreat buck for every \$5 you have spent (up to 30 retreat bucks)
